- Friday 27th June – Last day of term

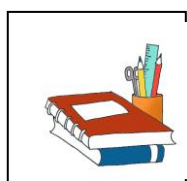

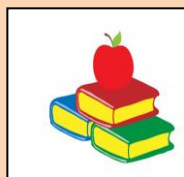
- Sumdog – Please remember homework tasks are on the website, use your login (you'll find it at the back of your child's homework jotter).

Other Curricular News

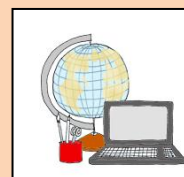
- Outdoor Learning – we are going to tidy up the Fairy Garden and Bug Hotel in the school playground. We will be learning about minibeasts exploring life cycles.
