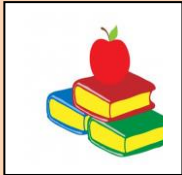

Right of the Month:

April 2025

Article (Right Number) 32: Governments must protect children from work that is dangerous or might harm their health or education.

May 2025

Article (Right Number) 6: Every child has the right to life. Governments must do all they can to ensure that children survive and develop to their full potential.

June 2025

Article (Right Number) 9: Children must not be separated from their parents unless it is in their best interests. Children's parents who have separated have the right to stay in contact with both parents, unless this might hurt the child.
