- In PE, we will focus on developing our badminton (this was interrupted with the Christmas schedule) and volleyball skills.

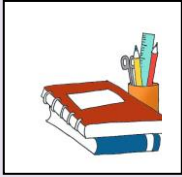

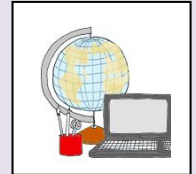
