Literacy and Language

- We will learn to hold and use our writing tools in the correct way.

- Sounds for term 1 are – s, a, t, i, p, n, m, d, o, c & k

Number Processes and Beyond Number

- We will learn to count forwards and backwards
- We will learn how to write each number, where it is on a number line, the value and whether it is odd or even.
- We will copy, continue and create simple patterns.

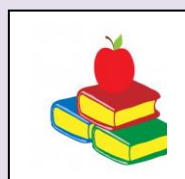
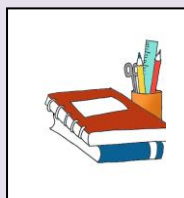

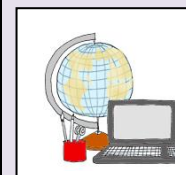
