Literacy and Language

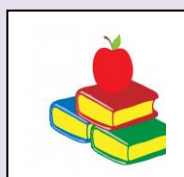
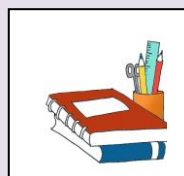

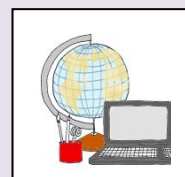
