Literacy and Language

- We will continue to copy letters underneath and from a board in our writing leading to independent writing.
- We will continue to learn the correct letter formations including capital letters and use them in our writing.
- We will continue to recognise the letter sounds and use them to blend words in our reading books.
- Term 3 sounds – ai, j, oa, ie, ee, or, z, w, ng, v, oo, y & x.
Please note the sound order may be slightly different in the Sounds Book as we are using a new Phonic Programme

Number Processes and Beyond Number

- We will count forwards and backwards from numbers.
- We will learn the correct formation of teen numbers and their value/place on the number line.
- We will continue to learn addition strategies and be introduced to subtraction.
- We will recognise all coins up to £2 and use them to make amounts.

Other Curricular News

- We will be learning about Winter and investigating water in different forms.
- We will be finding out about aspects of Scottish History. We will learn how people lived long ago and investigate Scottish Castles when a dragon comes to visit the classroom! We will also be finding out about Robbie Burns.
- In PE we will be working on our Gymnastic skills.
- In Drama we will be using imagination and movement.

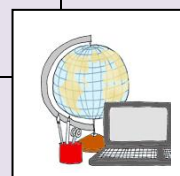
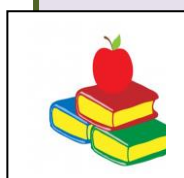
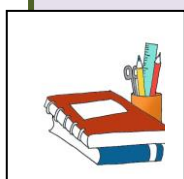
