Literacy and Language

- **Reading** – We will develop our comprehension and reading techniques through various activities.
- **Writing** – We will be working on using non-fiction texts to help us create reports. We will be developing our imaginative writing skills by developing characters and settings.
- **Spelling** – Through dictation and spelling games we will develop different phonemes and reinforce common words.
- **Listening/Talking** – Daily activities including talking partners and group work.
- **French** – Revision of numbers, days of the week, colours and greetings.

Number Processes and Beyond Number

- **Number Processes** – We will be developing our multiplication and division skills, sharing a variety of different mental and written strategies.
- **Time** – we will be revising how to read digital and analogue clocks before learning how to calculate durations in hours and minutes.
- **Measurement** – we will be consolidating reading different scales for these different types of measurement, weight, volume, distance.

Other Curricular News

- **Inter-Disciplinary Learning (IDL/Topic)** – This term we will be learning about where the Vikings came from, Viking traditions, Viking gods and the festival 'Up Helly Aa'.
- **Sciences** – We will look at magnets, things they attract and repel.
- **PE** – Creative Dance and Coaching at BCHS.
- **HWB** – Our unique skills and abilities – what makes us different.
- **Technologies** - Developing digital literacy skills, including logging on, saving documents and creating powerpoint presentations.
- **Expressive Arts** – We will create some decorations for Chinese New Year and drawings of Viking longships.

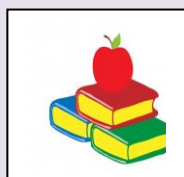
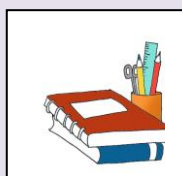
February 2026

*Article 12 – **You have the right to be listened to** – Your opinions matter, and adults should take them seriously as much as possible.*

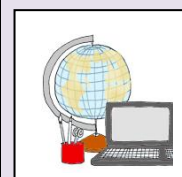
March 2026
