

Choose a strategy from the table below on a Monday and Wednesday night. Try not to choose the same strategies every week.

Buzzing Bees Draw and colour an outdoor picture. Count your spelling words. Draw a bee for each of your spelling words. Then write the words inside each of the "spelling" bees. Write neatly!	Colourful Words Write each of your spelling words. Write each letter using a different coloured pencil.	Connect the Dots Write your spelling words out once. Then write them out again next to it in dots. Connect the dots.	Choo-Choo Words Write the entire list of words end-to-end as one long word (like a train). Use a different coloured pencil for each word.
Spelling Flower Draw a flower with petals. Write your spelling words in each petal. Draw more than one flower if you need to. Colour your flowers in, lean lightly so as to not spoil your spelling.	Consonant Circle Write each of your spelling words. The go back and circle all of the consonants in your words! Don't forget to write neatly!	Three Times Write each spelling word three times. First, write each word in pencil. Second, write each word in crayon. Third, write each word in pen. You must write neatly! (You can write them pencil if you don't have crayons or pens.)	Pyramid Writing "Pyramid write" your spelling words. You must write neatly! e.g. home h ho hom home
Blue Vowels Write each of your spelling words. You will need a blue coloured pencil, trace over the vowels in each word with your blue coloured pencil.	Spell-er-size! Pretend you are a cheerleader and call out the letters of your words! Ask a parent to be your audience. Cheer up high for letter that touch the top handwriting line- h, l, b etc Hands on hips for middle letters – a, e i, m, etc And cheer down low for low letters – y, j, g etc.	Story, Story Write a story using All of your spelling words. Be sure to underline your spelling words in your paragraph.	Sentence, Please Write sentences using each of your spelling words. You may use more than one word in a sentence but you must write a P4 sentence. Try using adjectives to help you.
Trace a Shape Count your spelling words. Draw a shape for each word. Then write your word inside the shape.	Newspaper Spelling! Cut out letters from a newspaper, glue them into your jotter to spell your words.	Pasta Shapes! Lay out pasta in the shape of your spelling words. Ask a parent to check them for you.	Pass a Word Ask your parent to help you spell your words out loud. Write down in your jotter how many you got correct first time.
