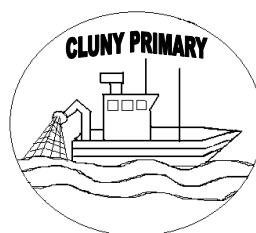

Welcome to another school session at Cluny Primary School. You will receive a class newsletter every term. We take this opportunity to outline some key aspects of our learning. Please note that these targets are adapted according to the individual abilities in class.

We hope you find this information is useful.

Literacy and Language

- In reading, pupils will work on fluency, understanding and expression.
- In writing, pupils will focus on expository texts: explanations, instructions and reports.
- In writing, pupils will work on developing sentence structure and use of punctuation, e.g. full-stops, commas, question marks and exclamation marks.

Number Processes and Beyond Number

- Pupils will work on their understanding of place value of whole numbers.
- Pupils will begin work on the 4 operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Pupils will work on estimation and rounding of whole numbers.

Other Curricular News

- Our science topic is Biodiversity and Interdependence which will include classification of living things; adaptation and extinction and how plants benefit society.
- In Health & Wellbeing pupils will work on the UNICEF Rights of the Child and on creating our class charter. We will discuss values such as respect and building positive relationships.
- In R.M.E pupils will research Mother Theresa.

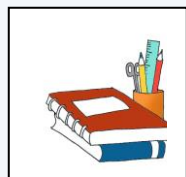

Please ensure that children wear a jacket and suitable shoes to school every day. Children should also bring a water bottle and a healthy snack.

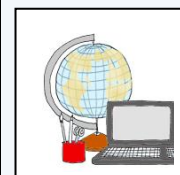
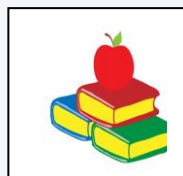
We have P.E. on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
