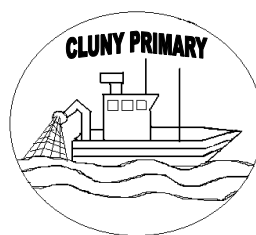

- We will continue to work on recognising our emotions and how to manage our feelings associated with them.

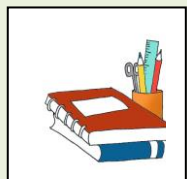

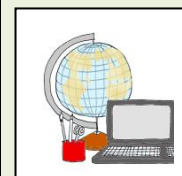
