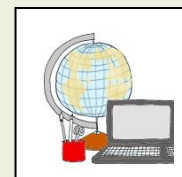
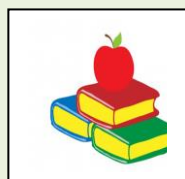
Monday and Friday
