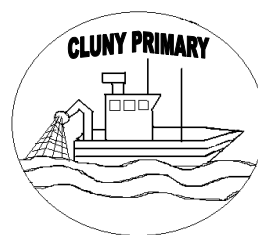

Literacy and Language

- We are using the literary skills we learned from descriptive writing to write poems in varying styles. We are using our technical skills to enhance our poetry. Later in the term we will be learning to write procedural texts.
- In Reflective Reading we are working in larger reading groups, trios and pairs to read and understand a differentiated variety of challenging and motivating texts.
- We have been expanding our understanding of literary devices such as juxtaposition and personification. We will be developing our knowledges of all types of verbs.

Number Processes and Beyond Number

- We will use our knowledge of the multiplication tables to develop our understanding of multiples, factors & primes.
- We will use our knowledge and understanding of the 4 operations in the context of money this term.
- We will develop our understanding of angles by investigating angles in our environment, measuring and calculating angle sizes and investigate this in context.

Other Curricular News

- This term we are working in teams to research our chosen country (Brazil) and studying it in comparison to Scotland. As teams, we will present our findings to the class.
- In science with Mr Doyle this term we are learning about chemical changes/reactions, such as dissolution. Later in the term we will be investigating forces like air resistance.
- In P.E. our focus is aesthetics. We will be joining with P7W to develop our skills in Scottish Country Dancing.

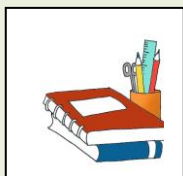

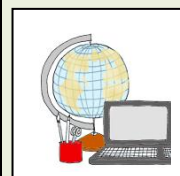
