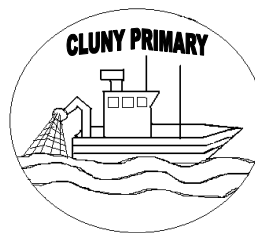

Literacy, Numeracy and Health and Wellbeing remains our priority and we will target these curricular areas in fun, interactive and motivational ways. As the weather remains cold and unpredictable, please ensure that pupils are dressed appropriately for going outdoors.

Literacy and Language

- We continue to focus on letters and sounds knowledge to enable us to read and write with growing confidence. The children learn through active games with their friends, in the classroom and outdoors.
- We will focus on writing in a range of genres, we will begin with letter writing encouraging pupils to work with key words on the board to create their own sentences.
- The reading books will be given out on a Monday and we ask the reading to be practised at home and ready to be heard again on a Thursday.

Number Processes and Beyond Number

- We are continuing to learn how to subtract a single and double digits.. Some children will continue to use Numicon, number lines and visual pictures to help them. Other children will be practise mental strategies to enable them to become more confident with this maths skill.
