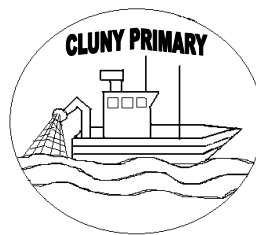

- First day of Term 4 – Monday 18th April

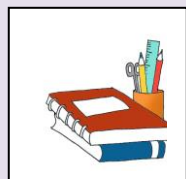

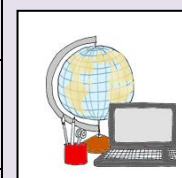
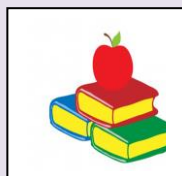
