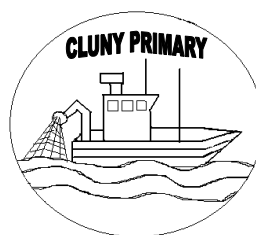

- We will learn about the human body.

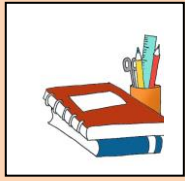

- 1st July – end of term

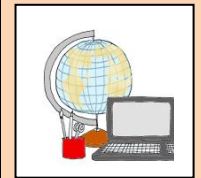
