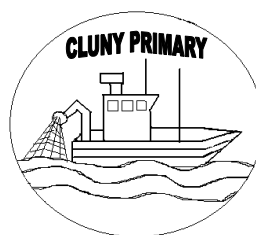

Literacy and Language

- Our focus this term is particularly on the phase 5 phonics. We will continue learning through active games in pairs and in groups within the class and outdoors. The children are thoroughly enjoying learning in this way.
- We will continue to use our phonics knowledge to extend writing in sentences. We will try to add more detail to our sentences, while also checking our work for capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and ensuring our work makes sense.
- Our reading is linked closely to our phonics and sounds work. Please remember to practise every night and read other books at home to build confidence in this area.

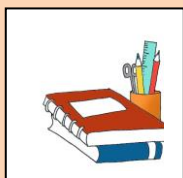
Number Processes and Beyond Number

- We have continued to practise subtraction with 1 and 2 digit numbers. We are revising skip counting with 2's, 5's and 10's. We will also explore multiplication and division this term, introducing them as sets of or groups of numbers, spotting patterns and making links.
- In other areas of maths, we are learning about estimation. We will learn what estimating means and how we use it in our everyday lives. Our work on estimation will be done through active tasks.

Other Curricular News

- This term we are learning all about Space. The children will be able to use their literacy and communication skills they have been learning this year to write facts and present information to the class.
- In PE we are starting to introduce a range of different exercises to build strength. This will be done with circuit training and also playing games outdoors. We will develop hand eye coordination through using bats and balls and continue using the skipping ropes and hoops outdoors too.

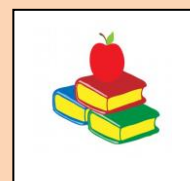
