

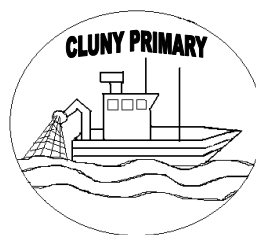
Cluny Primary School

Literacy and Language

- We continue to use our phonics knowledge to extend writing in sentences. We will focus on adding more detail while also checking our work for capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and ensuring our work makes sense.
- Our reading is linked very closely to our phonics and sounds work. Please remember to practise every night and read other books at home to build confidence in this area.

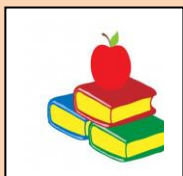
Number Processes and Beyond Number

- This term we are learning about estimation. We will discuss what estimating means and when we use it in our every day lives. We will learn about estimation through active tasks.

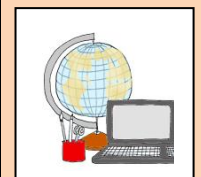
Other Curricular News
