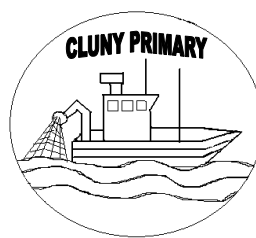

- In R.M.E, we will research Buddhism.

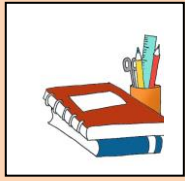

- 1st July – end of term

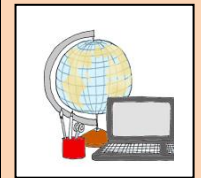
