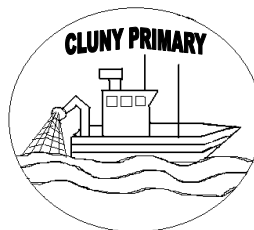

It is hard to believe that we are now in our final term of this academic year. It is lovely to see the sunshine make an appearance. Whenever possible, we will be doing our PE sessions outside and making use of our outside spaces. Literacy and Language

- In reflective reading sessions, we will focus on deepening our understanding of themes within our reading texts.
- We will begin the term with persuasive writing. In the second half of the term we will be having class debates which will support our discursive writing.
- This term we will be working on ensuring we have a sound understanding of all parts of speech. We will be learning about the rules of use for apostrophes.

Number Processes and Beyond Number

- We will use our knowledge and understanding of fractions to investigate the link between fractions, decimal fractions and percentages.
- We will be exploring measure in our environment, undertaking practical activities involving measure and using our knowledge of measure to solve contextual problems.
- We will be using our understanding of patterns to solve algebraic equations and problems involving BODMAS.

Other Curricular News

- Our I.D.L. topic this term is Space; the class will be learning about the solar system, including the key features of planets and moons.
- This term we will be learning about body systems in science and linking this to our developing understanding of health & fitness in P.E.
- Scottish Opera: *The Last Aliens*. Our practice sessions will be culminating in an exciting performance on the 9th of May.

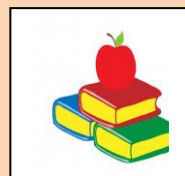
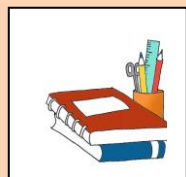

- 1st July – end of term

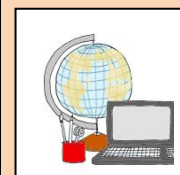
