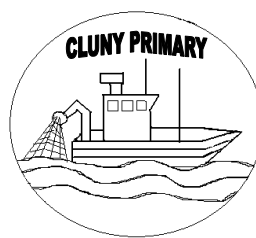

- All P7 pupils will participate in Outreach Moray Activities and End of Term fun!

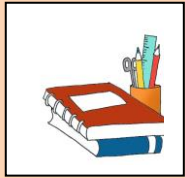

- 1st July – end of term

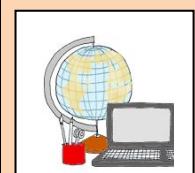
