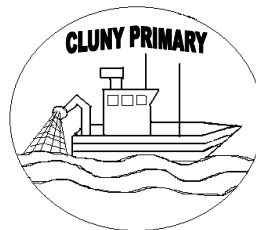

Literacy and Language

- Our main focus will be using our letters and phonics knowledge to read confidently and with fluency.
- We will continue to work on letter formation and size and show we can present our work neatly.
- We will continue to work more independently using our knowledge of spelling patterns and spelling word books.

Number Processes and Beyond Number

- Our main focus is to be able to add and subtract single and double digits. Some children will use concrete materials to help them.
- We will also continue to count in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- We will identify coins and work with money up to £1. We will look at recognising coins, using coins to make amounts to 10p and 20p.

Other Curricular News

- Our topic this term is Water. We will be reading the story Water Boy which is about a boy who can move water with his special powers. We will also be learning about the water cycle and different types of energy. We'll carry out some science experiments too.
- We are learning numbers to 10 in French and hope to move onto greetings soon.

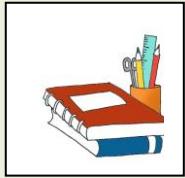

We have PE on a Wednesday and Friday each week.

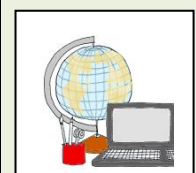
Please ensure that children wear a jacket and suitable shoes to school every day. Children should also bring a water bottle and a healthy snack.
