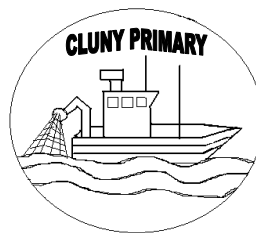

Literacy and Language

This term we will be:

- a continued focus on building our phonics knowledge. We will continue to learn through a range of games and activities which support the phase we are working on.
- We will focus on writing with growing independence using key words from the board, our phonics knowledge and with an increased understanding of spelling patterns.
- Reading books will be given out on a Monday, please practise reading and phonics boards every night at home ready to be heard again/assessed on Thursday/Friday.

Number Processes and Beyond Number

This term we will be:

- We are continuing to learn how to subtract a single and double digit number. Some children will continue to use Numicon, number lines and visual pictures to help them. Other children will practise mental strategies to enable them to become more confident.
- We will be moving onto learning about time, starting with o'clock and half past. Our aim is to read quarter to and quarter past using an analogue and digital clock.

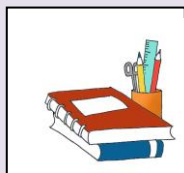

Other Curricular News

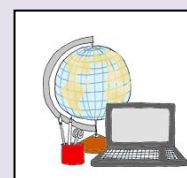
This term we will be:

Right of the Month:

January 2023

Article 12: Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters affecting them, and to have their views considered and taken seriously. This right applies at all times, for example during immigration proceedings, housing decisions or the child's day-to-day home life.

February 2023

Article 30 – Children have the right to use their own language, culture and religion.

March 2023

Article 17 – Children have the right to get information from the internet, radio, television, newspapers, books and other sources. Adults must make sure this information is not harmful.
