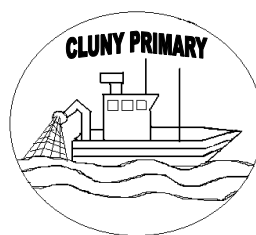

Literacy and Language

- We continue to use our phonics and spelling knowledge to help us add more detail when we are writing in sentences.
- Our reading is linked very closely to our phonics and sounds work. Please remember to practise every night and read other books at home to build confidence in this area.

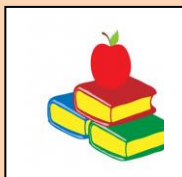
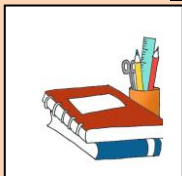
Number Processes and Beyond Number

- We will continue to use our knowledge of skip counting to learn multiplication and division. We are introducing them as groups of numbers, spotting patterns and making links between both to help them find the answer. The children will also explore these maths concepts using a range of concrete materials.
- This term we are also learning about measurement, data handling and fractions.

Other Curricular News

- This term we will be learning about Space. The children will be able to use their literacy and communication skills they have learned this year to write facts and present information to the class. We will be finding out about the Solar System throughout the term.
- In PE we are starting to introduce a range of different exercises and resources to build strength. We are also learning about the parts of the body and how to regulate our emotions through activities and music.
