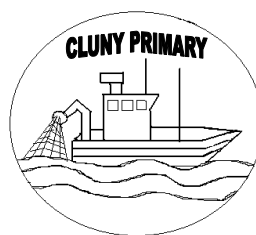

- We will be learning about plants, food chains and ecosystems which will allow us to design a wildlife area.

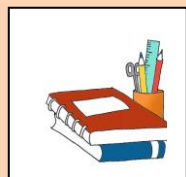

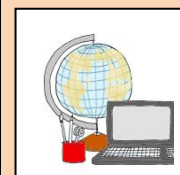
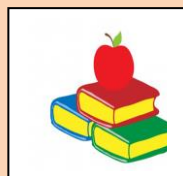
