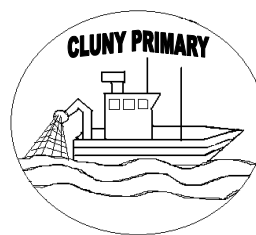

Welcome to another school session at Cluny Primary School. You will get a class newsletter every term. We take this opportunity to outline some key aspects of our learning. Please note that these targets are adapted according to the individual abilities in class.

We hope you find this information is useful.

Literacy and Language

- Phonics and letter blending will be our main focus this term. Children are being assessed to enable them to access resources which encourage them to learn at the right level. Phonics boards will go home soon, please take time each night to learn the sounds.
- This term we will be working particularly hard on writing. We will aim to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces correctly, while also encouraging pupils to form letters correctly during all writing tasks.
- Spelling - will go home each Monday, please return on a Thursday. Remember these words need to be practised every night, it's a good idea to take a screenshot of them and you can practise at any time!

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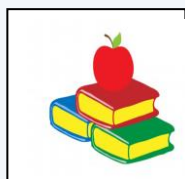
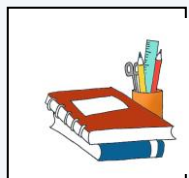
Number Processes and Beyond Number

- During our mental maths sessions we are focusing on number bonds. We are using our knowledge of fast recall of numbers to find number bonds of 10,20,30 and beyond. Please could you spend time with your child to revise bonds to 10 please.
- Skip counting in 2's, 5's and 10's (P2s) Skip counting in 3's and 4's (P3s) P3s starting to work on times tables (carried on from the introduction to multiplication and division from P2.)
- Miss Laing will focus on 2D and 3D shape.

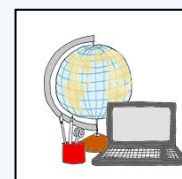
Other Curricular News

- We will revise our French knowledge from P1 and P2 initially making sure the learning is embedded.
