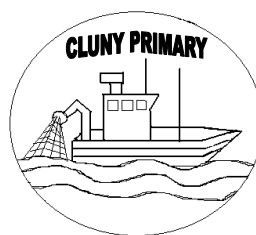

- We will be learning about Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day, Children in Need, St Andrews Day and Christmas.

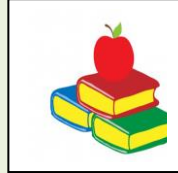
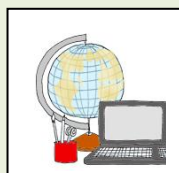
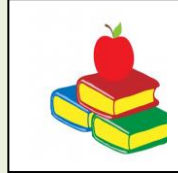
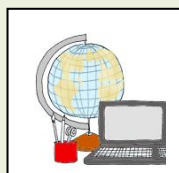
