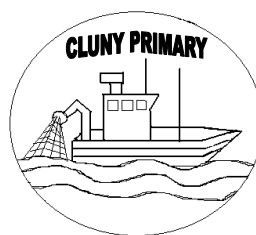

- We will learn about the human body.

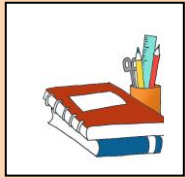

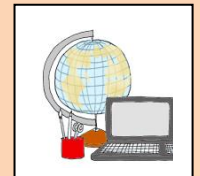
